**Topics to be included: Basic cardiac anatomy and physiology, common congenital cardiac defects and associated treatments, arrhythmias, MDT involvement, acquired cardiac disease, nursing management of the unwell cardiac patient and postoperative complications.**

**The programme aim is to consolidate your knowledge and improve your nursing assessment and management of cardiac patients in both primary and tertiary settings. The course will be delivered using a blended approach; face to face and virtual delivery and will include some simulation practice to complement learning**

**The cost of the course is £500. There are some free places available supported by the Thames Valley and Wessex Congenital Heart Disease Network.**
